I commit to having fun and modeling authentic friendship with the new members.

I commit to modeling behavior that is in alignment with Beta's core values, mission and vision throughout recruitment and new member orientation period.

I commit to adequately preparing for the program.

This includes but is not limited to:

- Adopting an attitude of over-preparation.
- Reviewing the facilitation guide and materials well in advance.
- Practicing my facilitation.
- Making copies (if necessary) and purchasing/gathering supplies at minimum one day before the next new member session.
- Seeking support from Beta Theta Pi staff and advisors when needed.

I commit to showing up early to every new member session.

This helps me to ensure:

- That the room is set up appropriately for the activities of the session.
- That I have the freedom to greet new members as they arrive.

This emphasizes:

- The importance of building strong relationships and therefore a strong brotherhood.
- That you are a supportive resource for new members throughout their new member orientation experience.

I commit to completing all pre-work which will be assigned to my new members throughout this pilot.

This helps me answer questions about the pre-work as I'm assigning it to new members such as:

- The value of each assignment
- The expected time on task for each assignment (Tip: You can do this before your fall semester begins or you can complete each week's pre-work one week before it is assigned to your new members.)

I commit to holding the Actives accountable to the following during the New Member Orientation period:

- Being engaged with the new members
- Avoiding activities that result in new members being humiliated, shamed, or embarrassed and intervening to stop such practices whenever possible.
- Avoiding activities that result in new members having earn their place in the brotherhood and intervening to stop such practices whenever possible.
- Modeling healthy group membership through participation in chapter meetings, service, and campus life.
