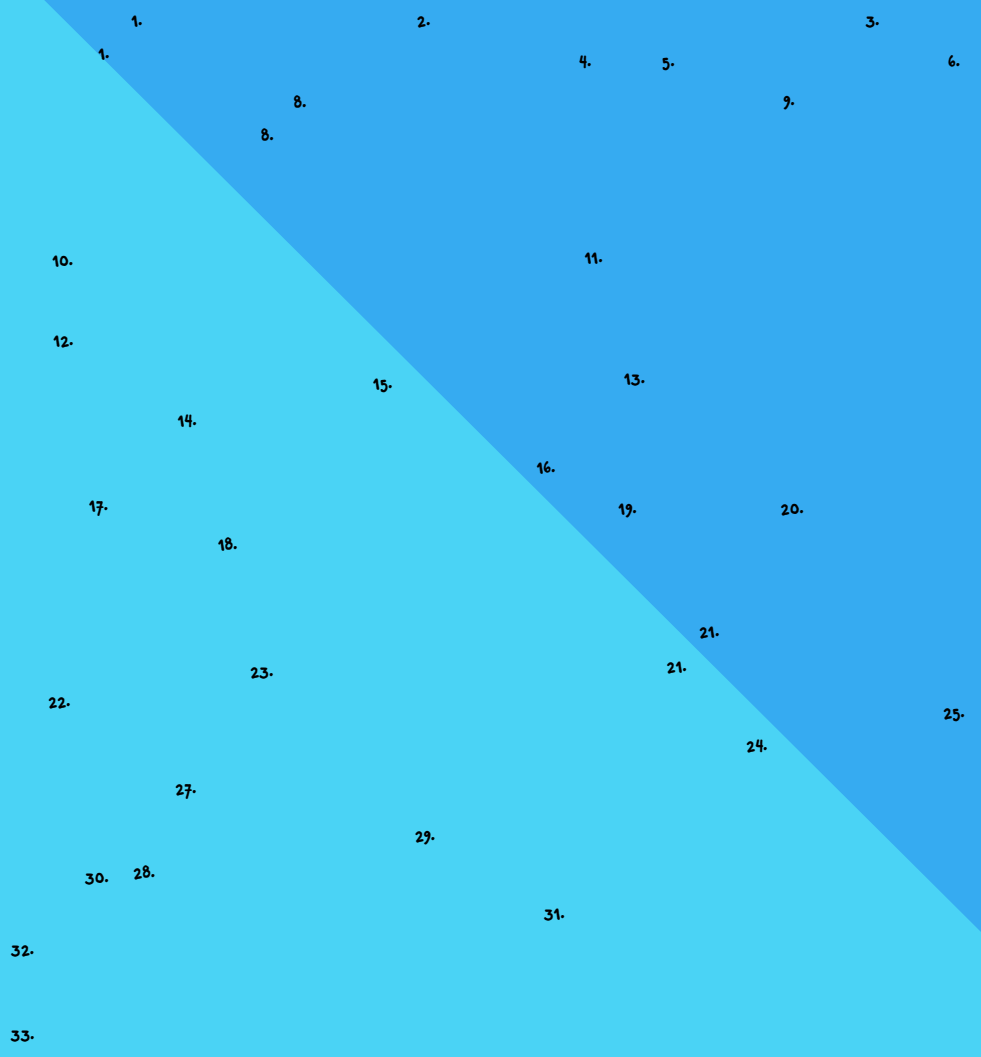

Complete the crossword by filling in a word that fits each clue.

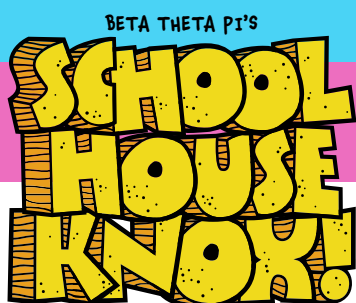
